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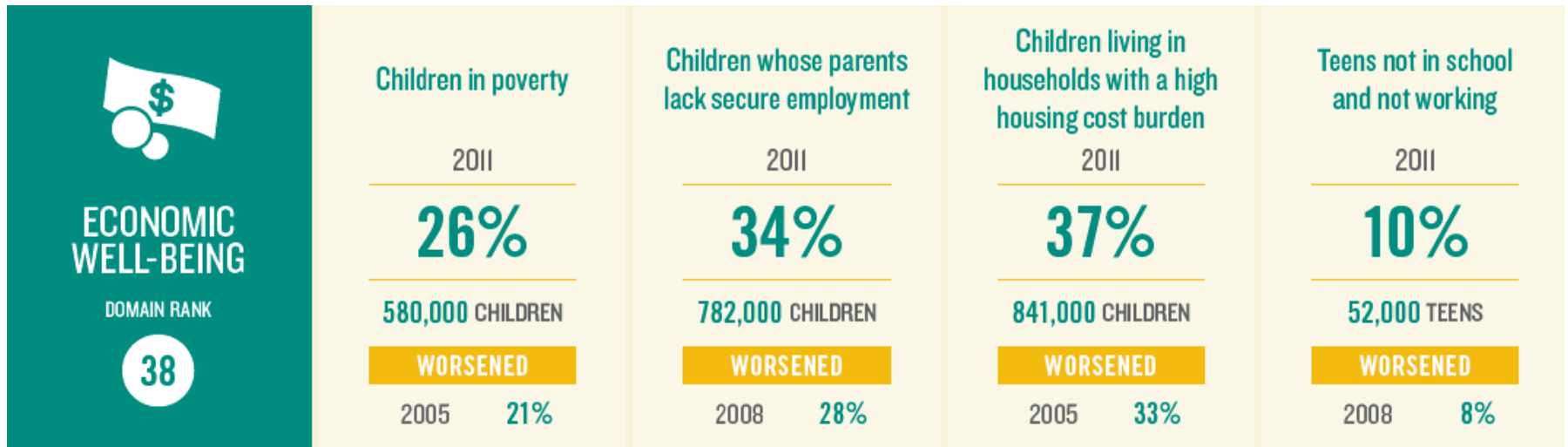

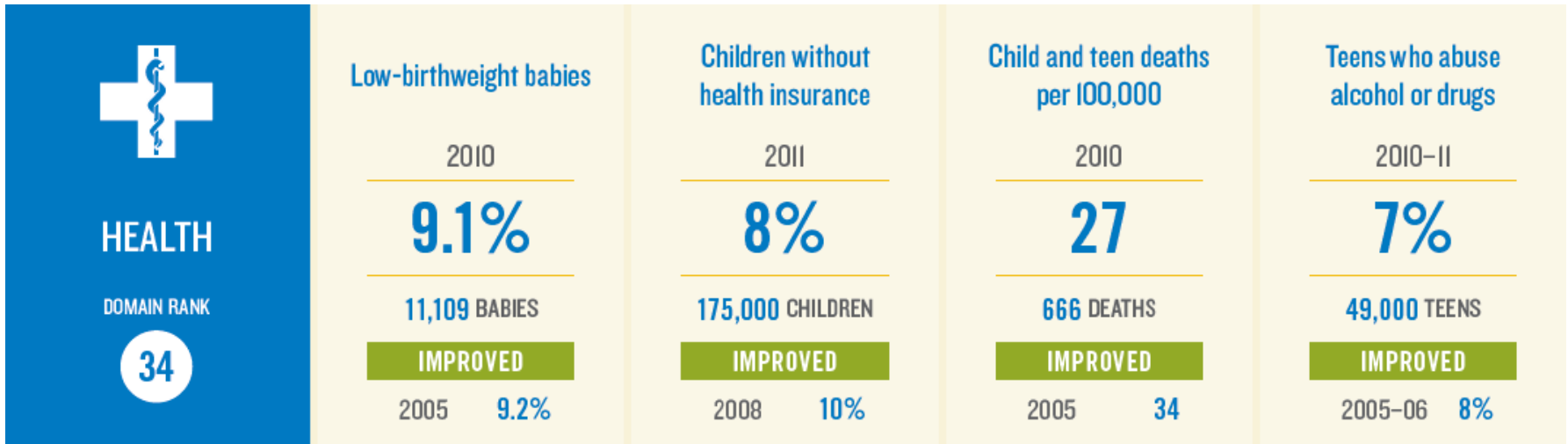

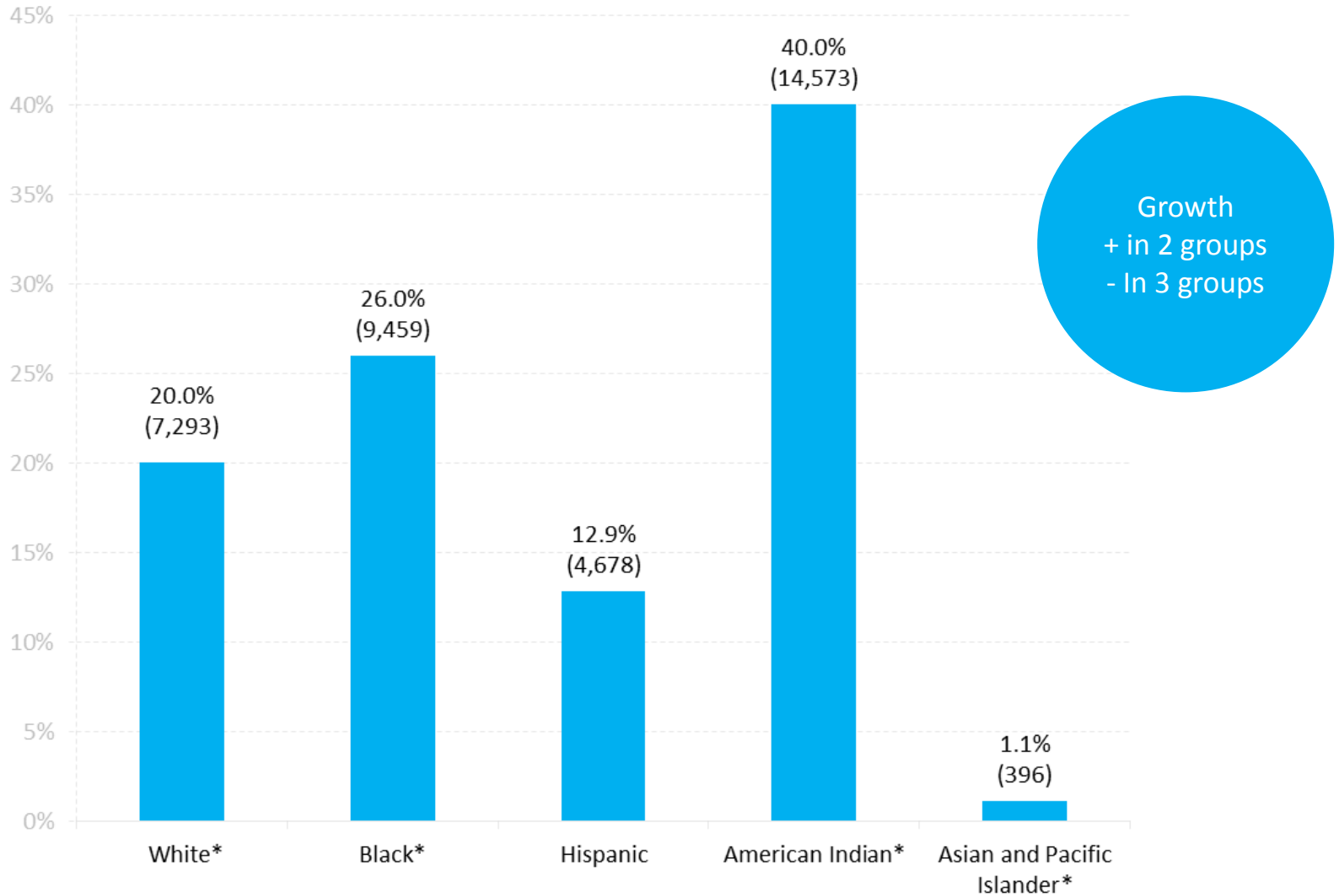

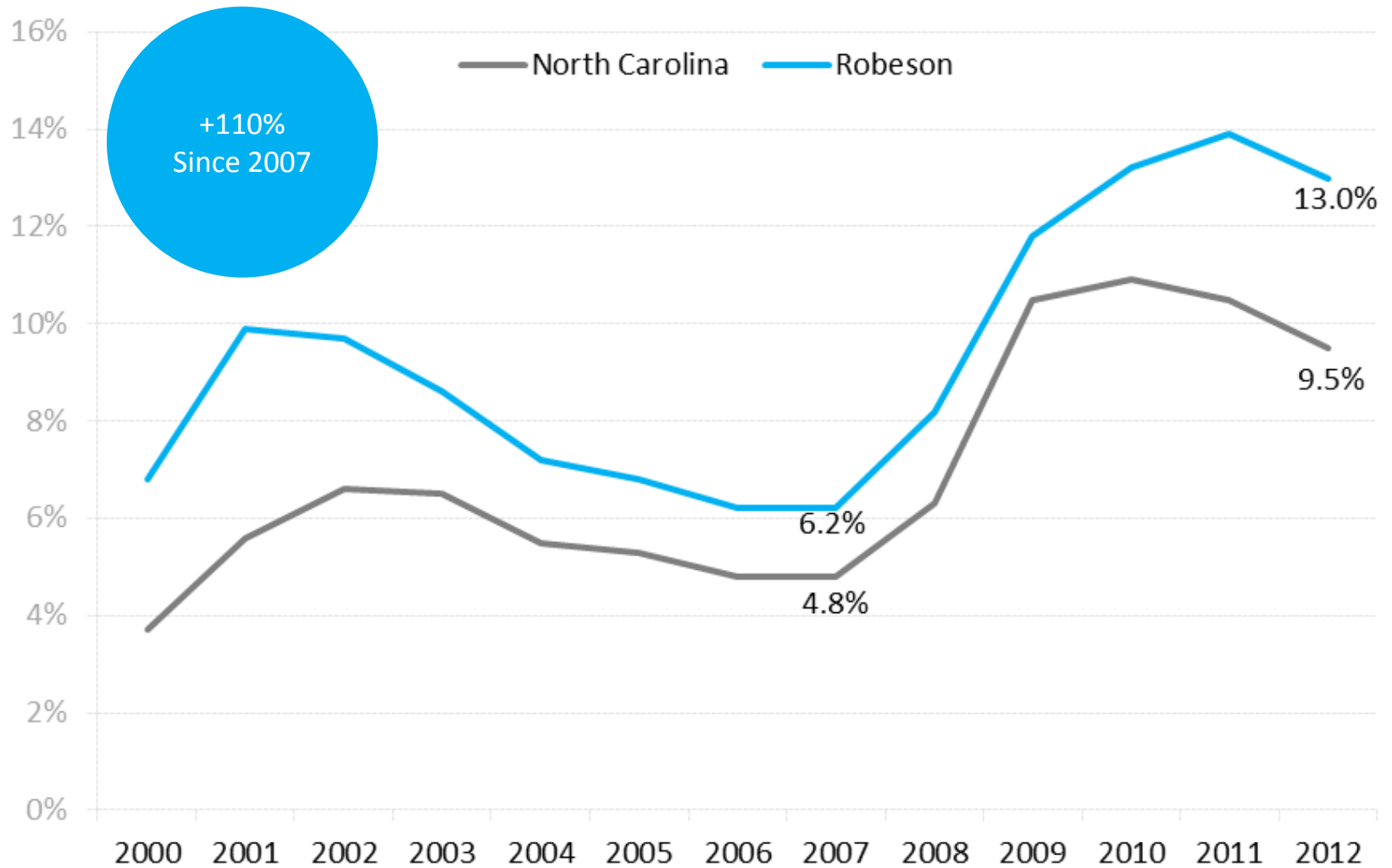


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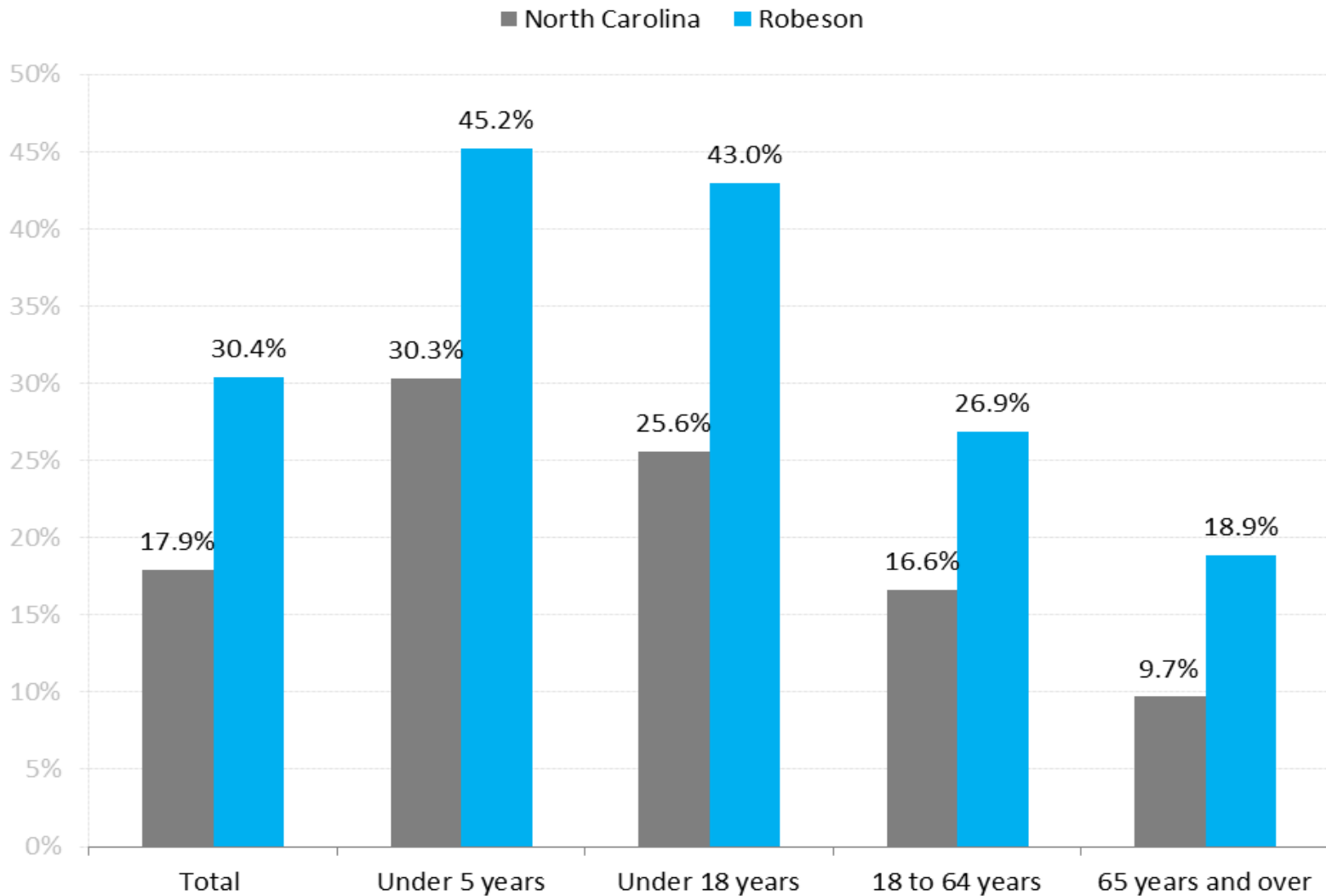

Unemployment Rate, 2000-2012



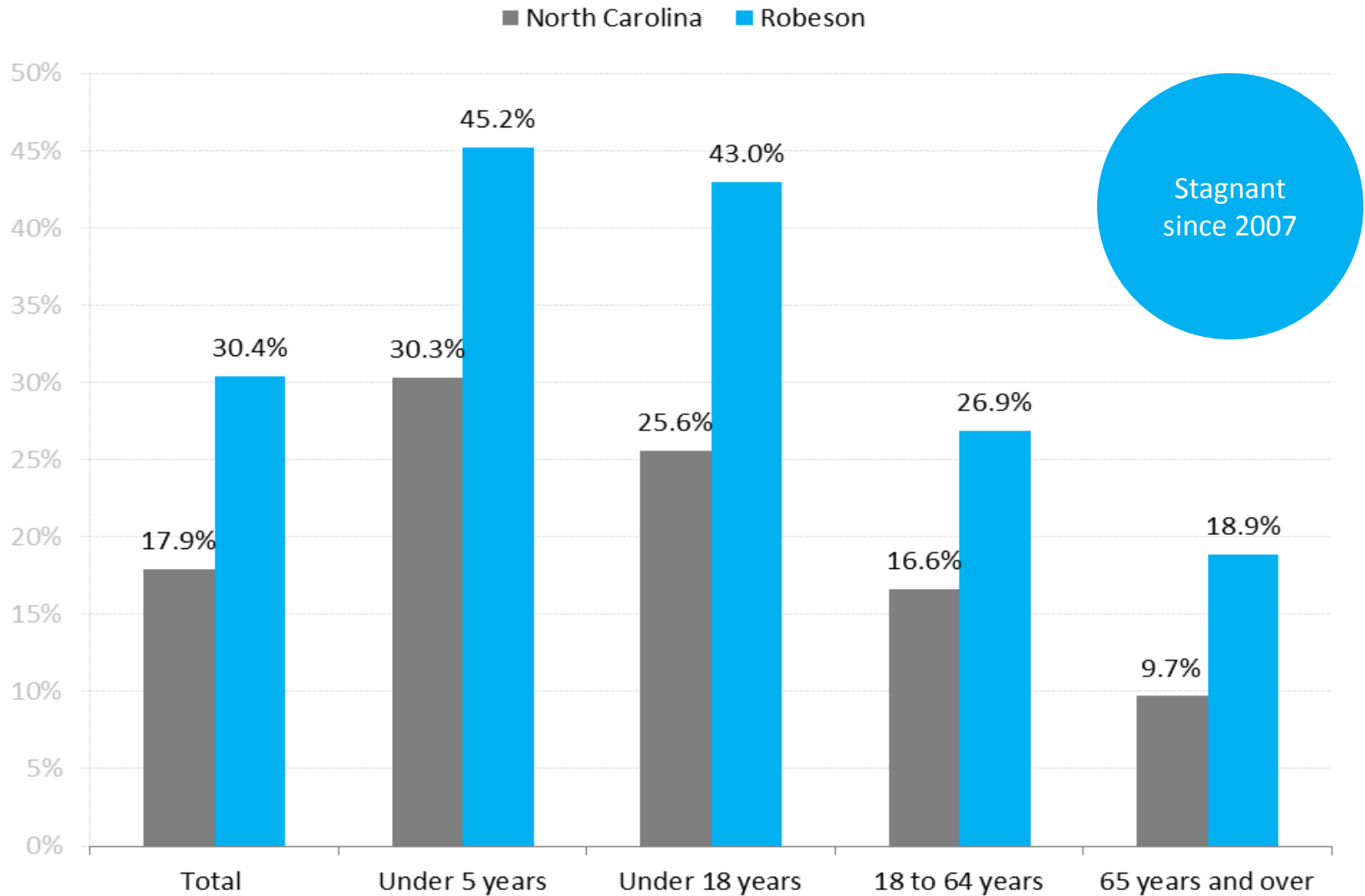

Housing Affordability

- * Income is only one part of financial security; the cost of basic expenses also matters.
- * BTC's *Living Income Standard* found a single parent with two children in Robeson County would need to earn \$39,016 a year to pay basic living expenses.
- * Housing and child care are typically families' largest expenses.

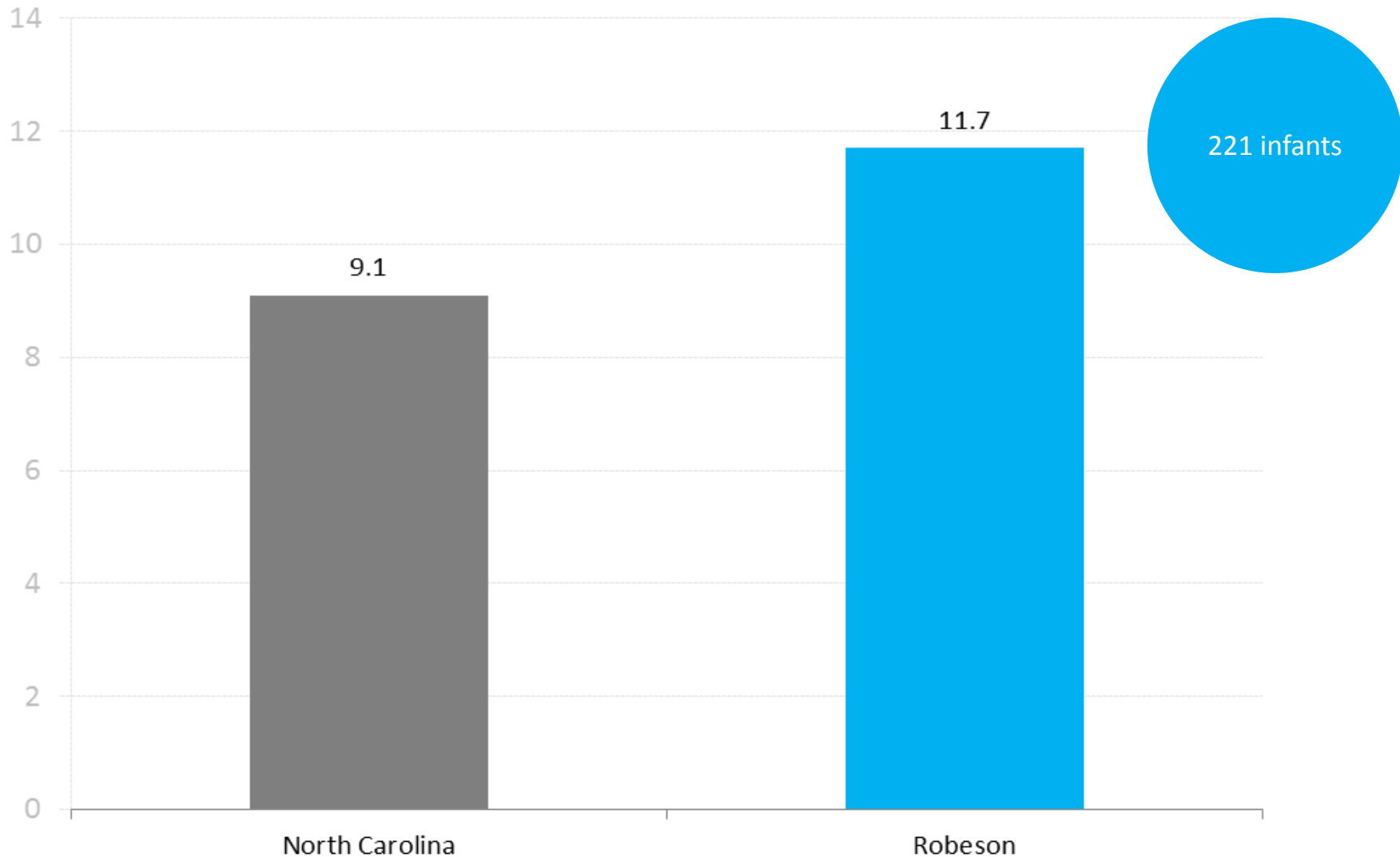


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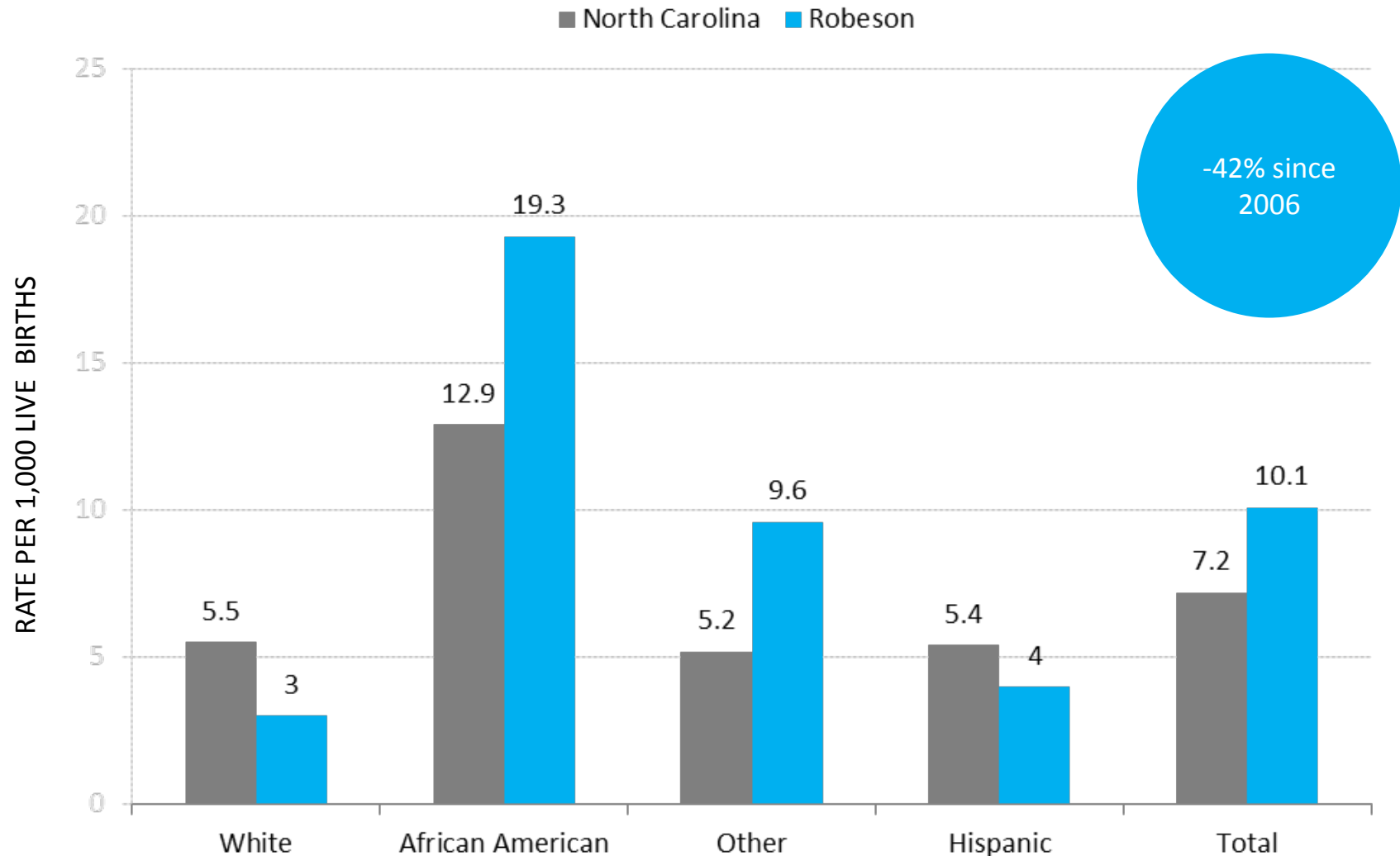

Percent of Infants Born at Low Birth-Weight, 2011



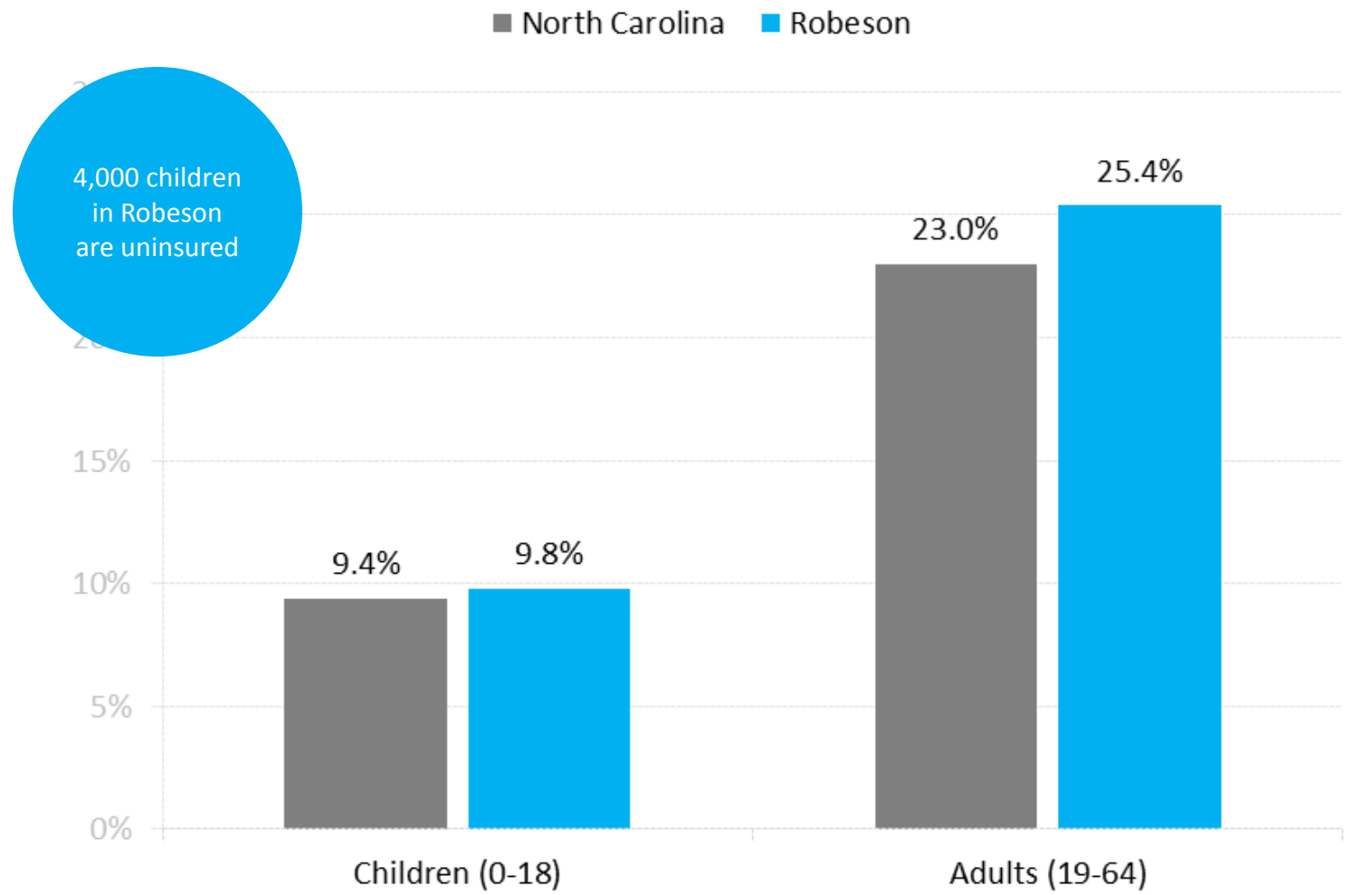

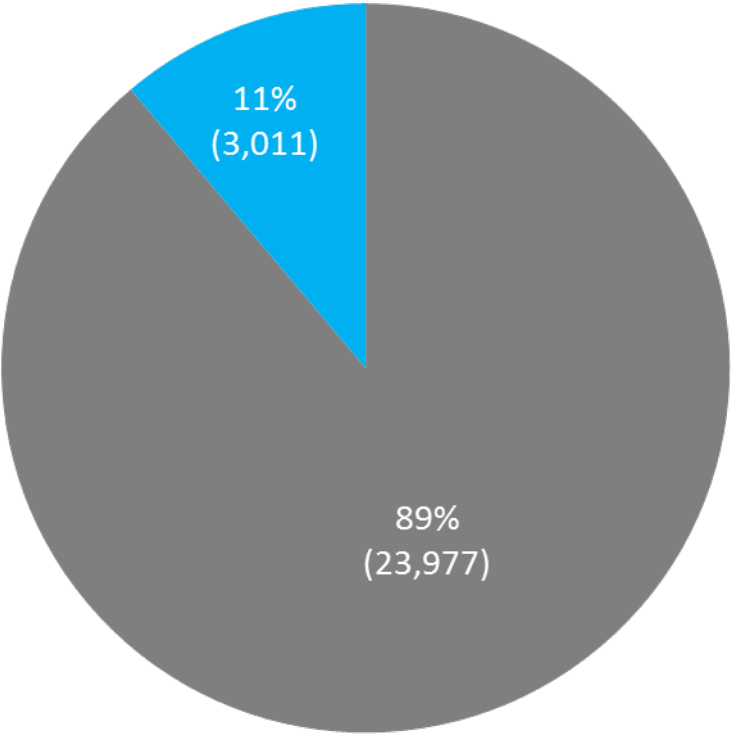
Uninsured Population by Age, 2011

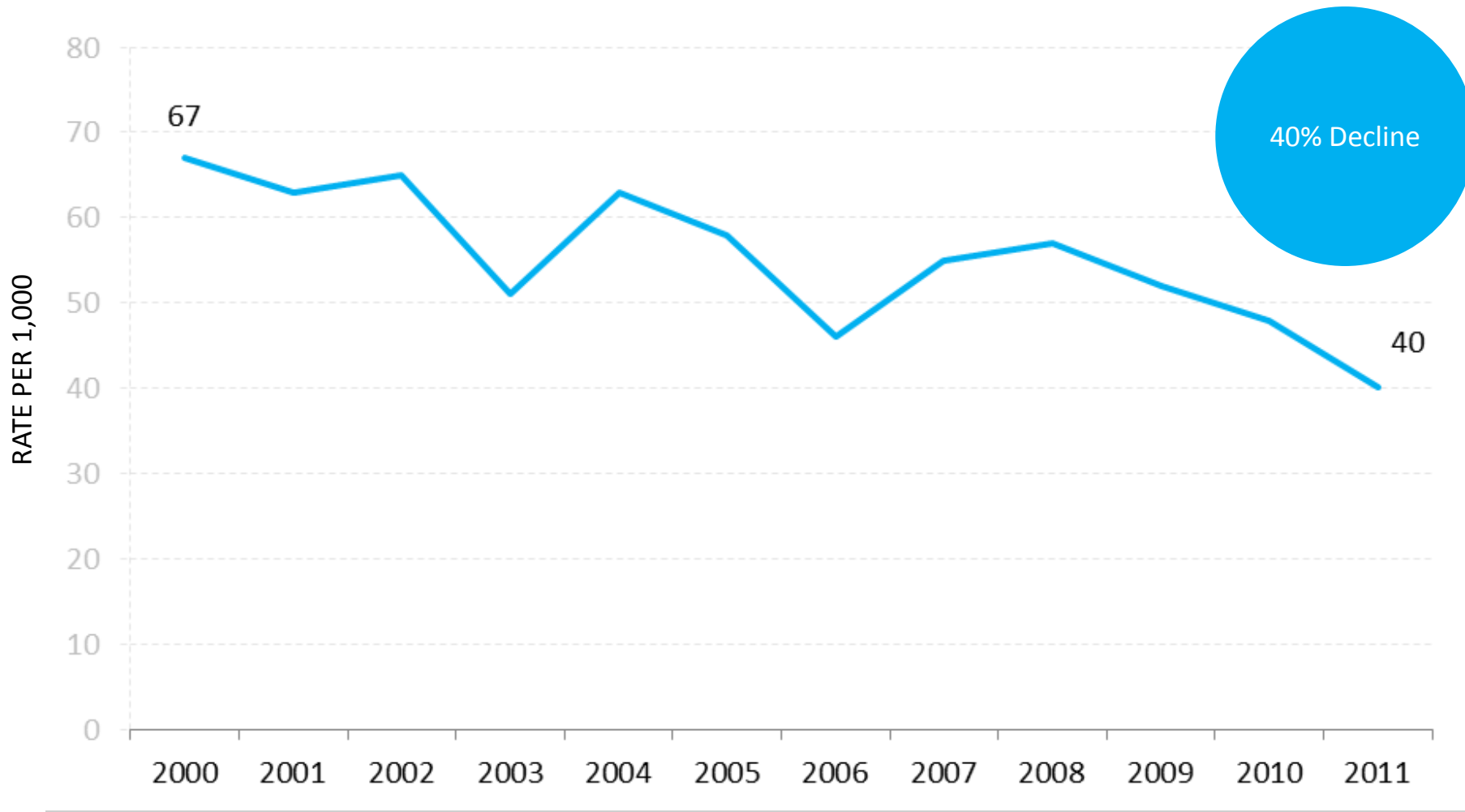

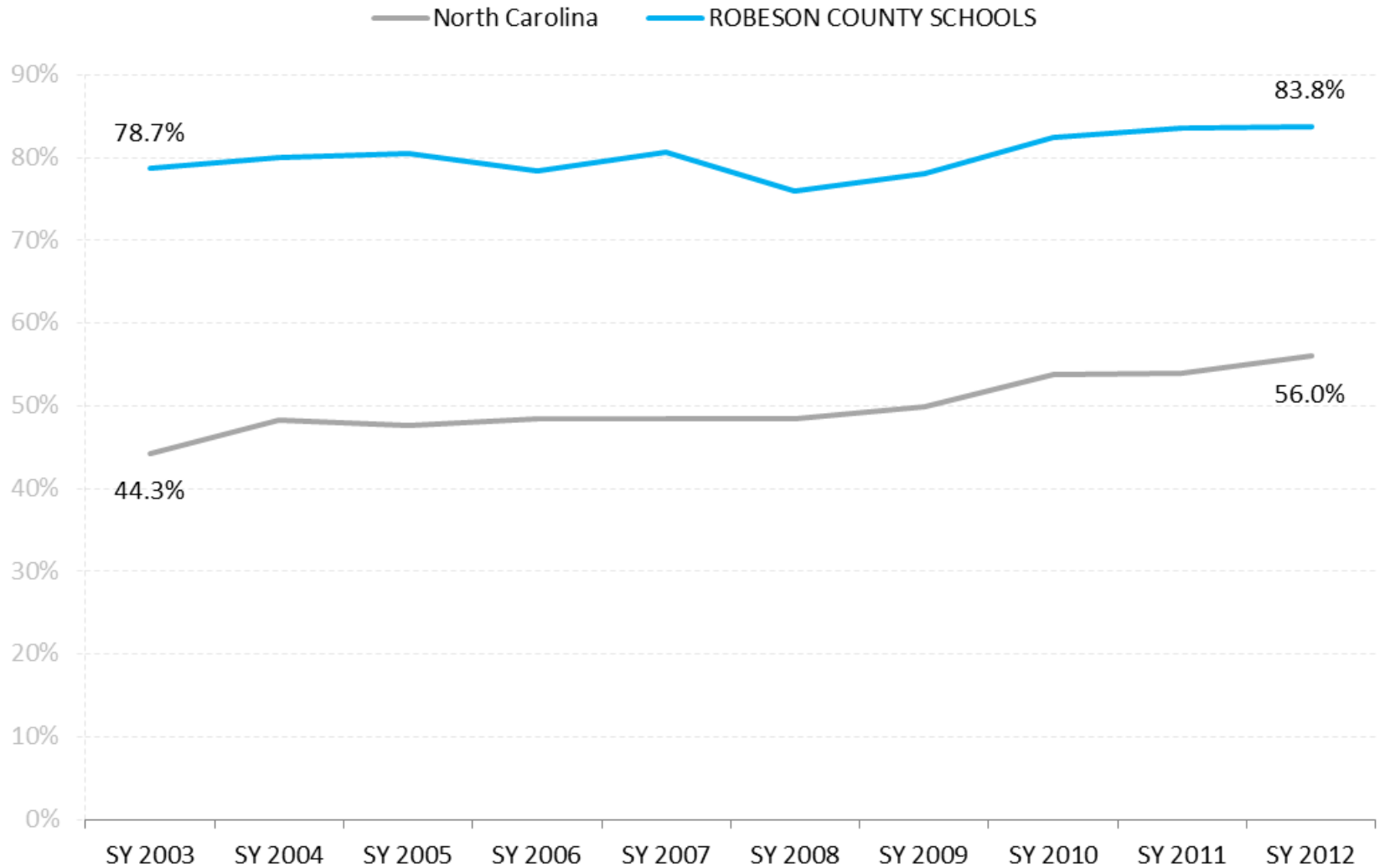


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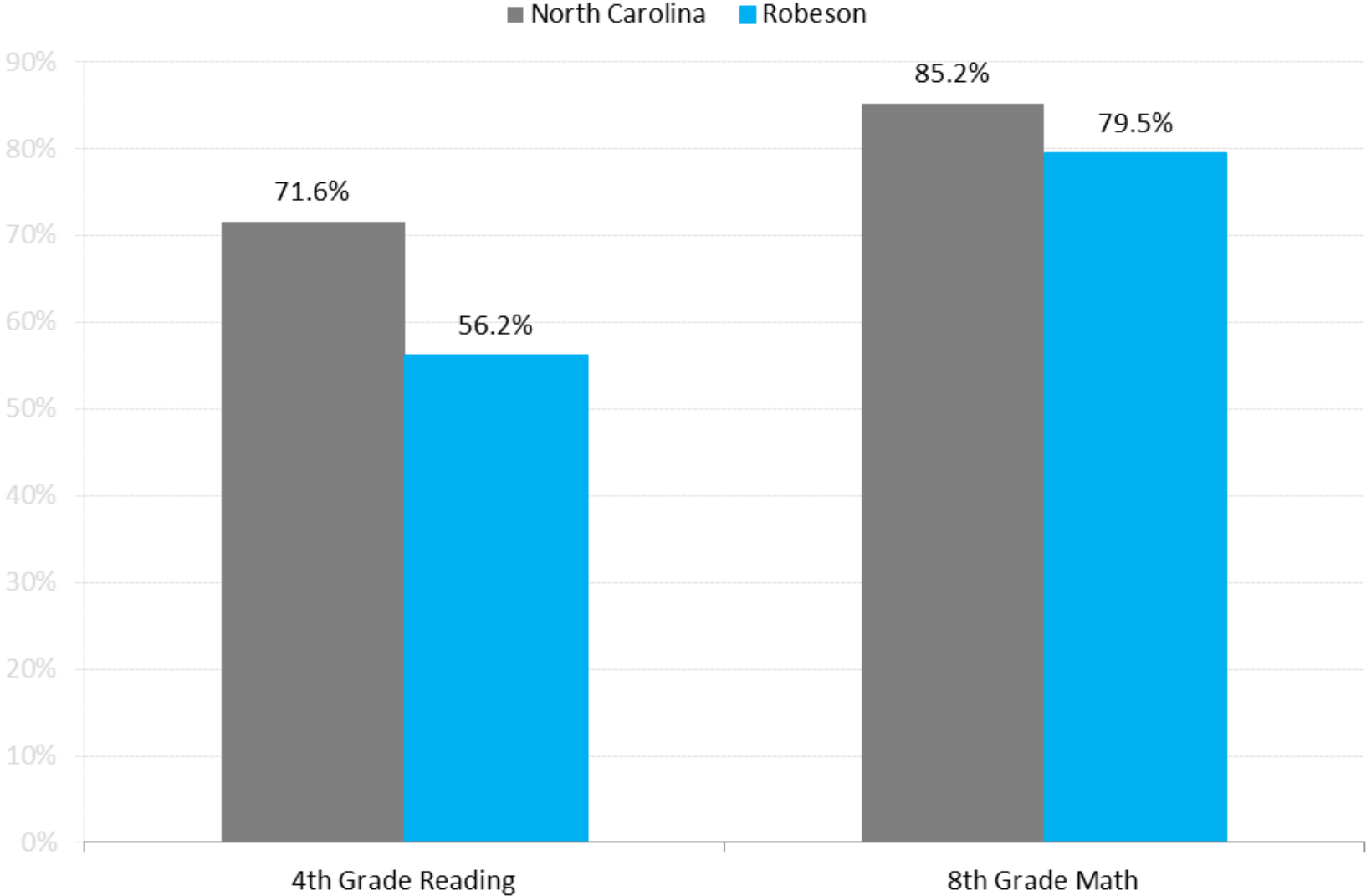

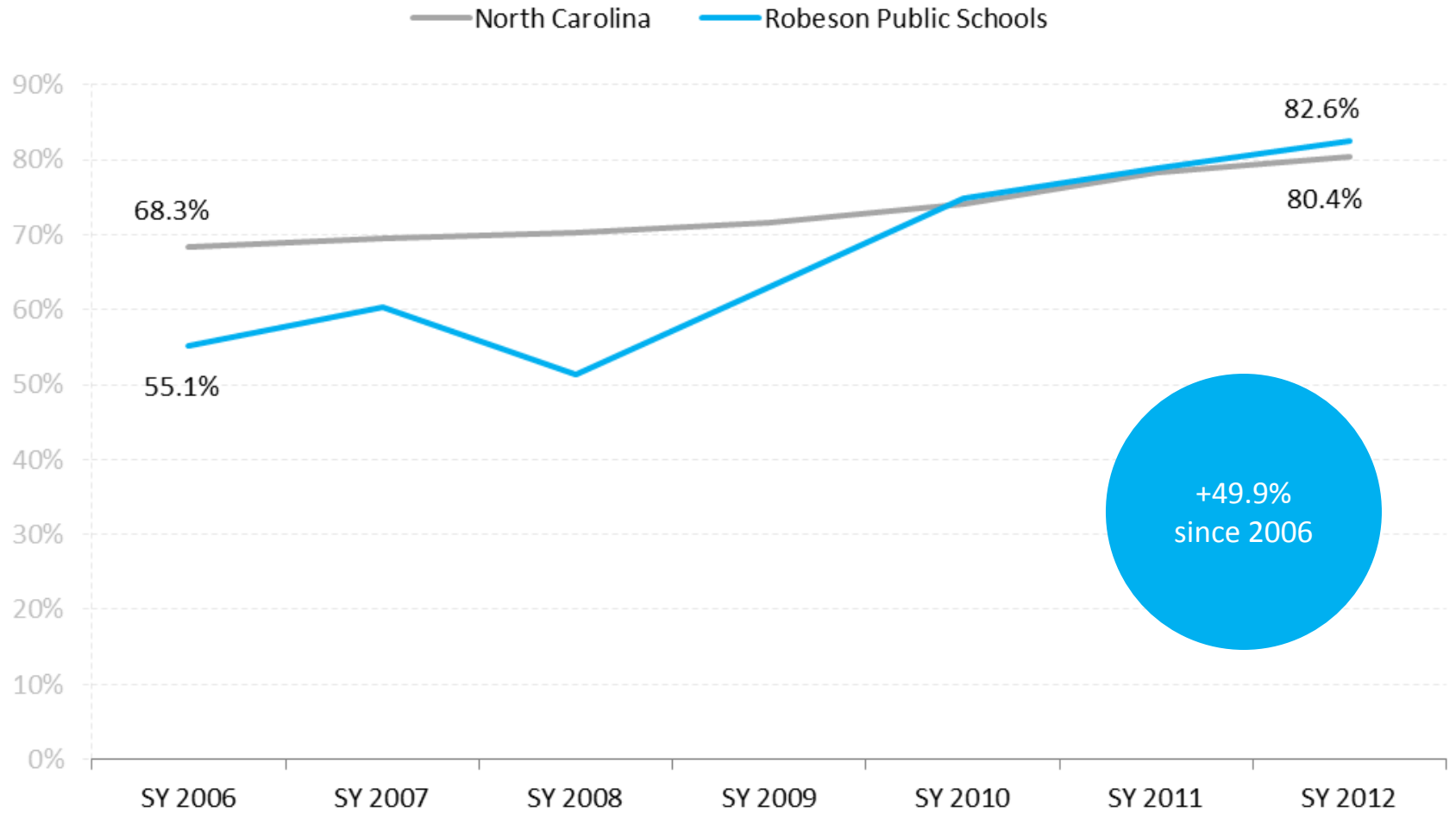

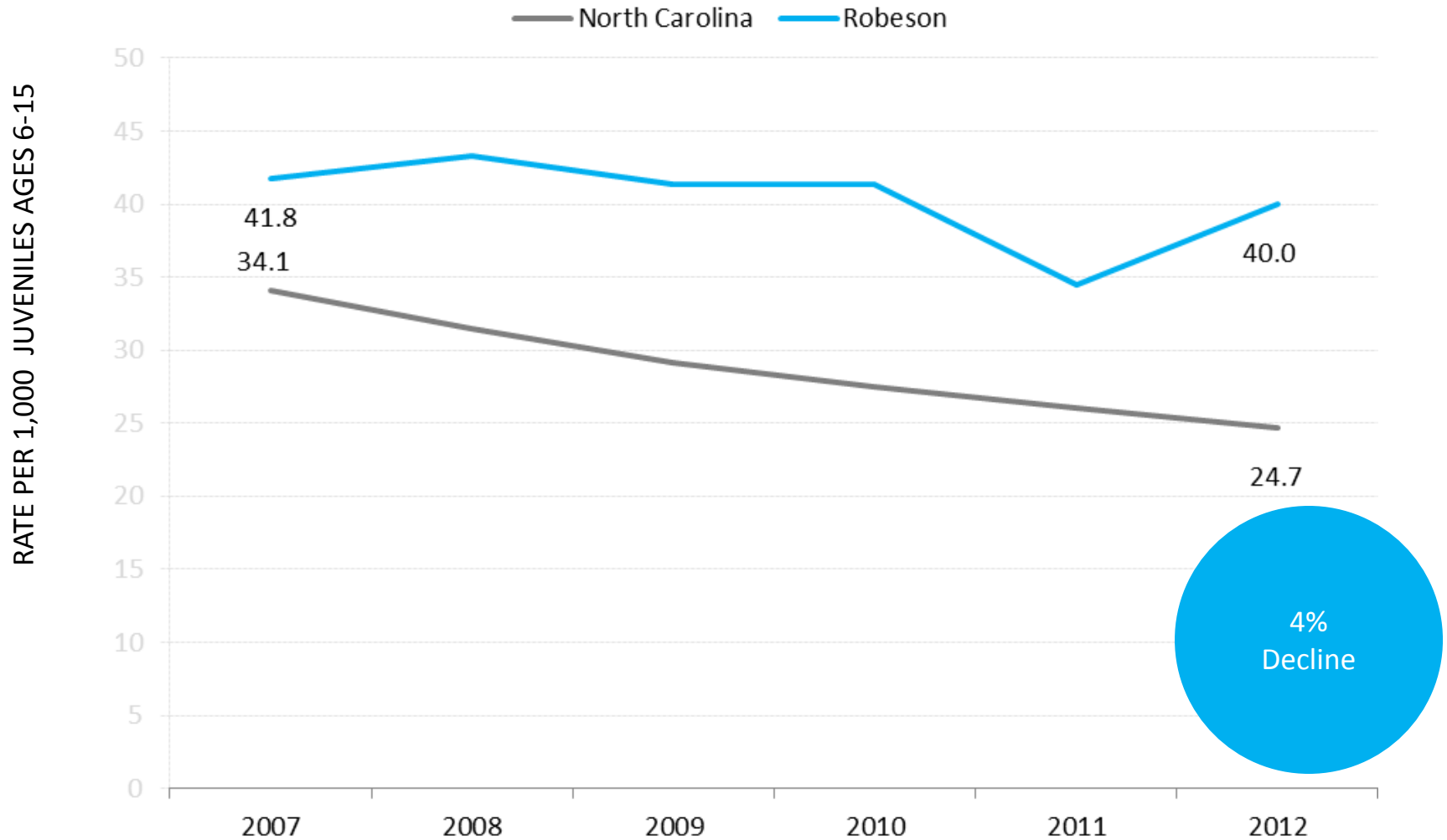


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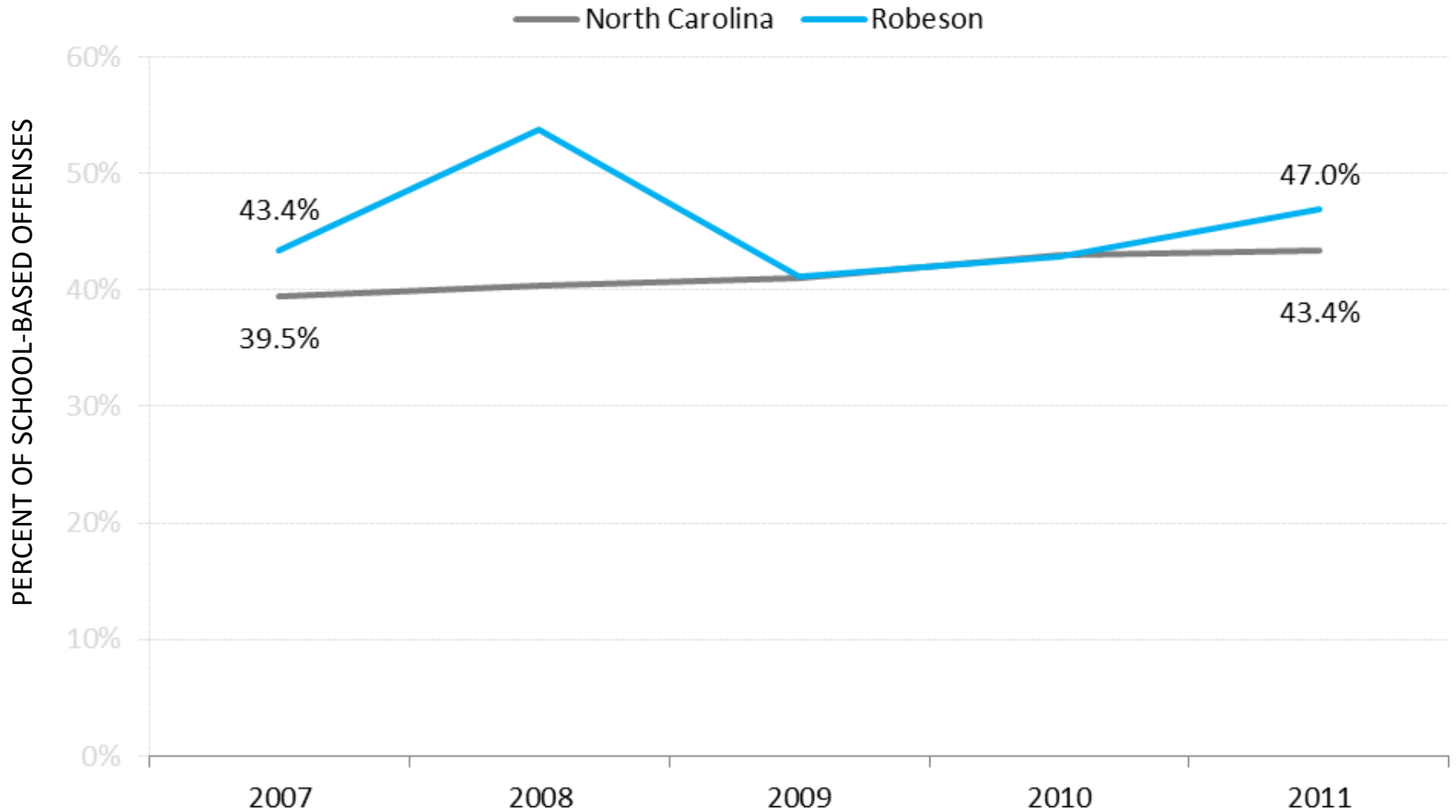
